To preserve the unique taste and quality of the Baccari and SGCO wines, they are stored lying at a constant temperature of 12° and out of sunlight.

With the slow-roasting process bringing out the richness of each coffee bean, the unique aroma of each African variety is brought to life. For every kilo of Pure Africa Coffee bought, $\in 1$ is invested in microcredit loans to agricultural entrepreneurs in Africa to then buy new land, trees or fertilisers.
