DAY 1: THE DUTCH AFRICA POULTRY FORUM (MONDAY 19TH OF MAY)

Held at Aeres University of Applied Sciences in Dronten, the first day offers an engaging and insightful programme designed to connect African and Dutch stakeholders in the poultry sector. The day begins with tailored B2B matchmaking sessions, providing delegates with the opportunity to establish direct connections with Dutch poultry companies offering relevant solutions. This is followed by inspiring keynote speeches delivered by prominent industry leaders and government, addressing the future of the poultry value chain and opportunities for collaboration. Delegates will then participate in interactive breakout sessions focusing on key topics such as feed production, breeding, animal health, and housing solutions. The day concludes with a networking reception, fostering meaningful relationships and knowledge exchange among participants.



DAY 2: INSPIRATIONAL COMPANY VISITS (TUESDAY 20TH OF MAY)

On the second day, delegates will experience practical demonstrations of innovation and expertise by visiting leading Dutch poultry companies. Participants can choose between two dedicated tracks based on their interests and expertise. Track 1 focuses on feed production and breeding/hatching, showcasing practical techniques and technologies to improve productivity and efficiency. Track 2 highlights solutions in animal health, biosecurity, and housing systems, addressing critical challenges in poultry farming. These immersive visits not only provide hands-on exposure but also allow delegates to explore collaborative opportunities directly with the host companies.



DAY 3 & 4: TRAINING SESSIONS (WEDNESDAY 21ST & THURSDAY 22ND OF MAY)

Receive hands-on training at our knowledge partner Aeres Training Centre in Barneveld. Topics include poultry farming, feed production, and sustainable practices, delivered by expert instructors.
