INCOMING POULTRY TRADE MISSION FROM THE DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO TO THE NETHERLANDS

In close collaboration with the Netherlands Enterprise Agency (RVO) and the Dutch Embassy in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), the NABC is organising a poultry-focused trade mission for a delegation of 15 Congolese professionals. This visit, taking place from **the 29th of June until 5th of July**, and is part of ongoing efforts to strengthen trade relations between the DRC and the Netherlands and accelerate the development of Congo's poultry sector through knowledge exchange, partnerships, and innovation.

This mission aims to connect Congolese stakeholders with leading Dutch companies, technology providers, and research institutions. During the week-long programme in Amersfoort, participants will engage in site visits, matchmaking sessions, and interactive workshops focused on strengthening local poultry production, improving feed systems, and enhancing value chain efficiency. By sharing Dutch expertise and exploring commercial collaboration, this mission seeks to improve food self-sufficiency in the DRC, reduce reliance on imports, and unlock economic opportunities for both Congolese and Dutch businesses. Ultimately, this mission supports long-term sectoral growth, job creation, and sustainable agriculture in the DRC.
