Uganda Coffee Development Authority's (UCDA) mandate is to promote, regulate and oversee the quality of coffee along the entire value chain, support research and development, promote production, and improve the marketing of coffee in order to optimise earnings for coffee stakeholders and the country.

UCDA has set ambitious strategic goals to transform and strengthen Uganda's coffee sector. Namely:

- **Production and Productivity:** UCDA aims to expand coffee cultivation areas by 15% and increase yield per tree from 550g to 880g, boosting overall output.
- **Quality and Value Addition:** The focus is on reducing post-harvest losses by 50% throughout the value chain to enhance efficiency and profitability.
- **Market Research and Development:** UCDA seeks to improve access to market information for sector players, increase direct coffee exports by 29% over three years, and position Uganda as a global centre of excellence for Robusta coffee.
